

The Top 10 Things You Need to Know To Have a Great Year at St. Philip!

This is a quick reference guide to the top 10 things you need to know, to have a fun year at St. Philip Lutheran School!

#1 Parking - The entire parking lot, **except for the red curb zone**, is available for drop-off , pick-up of your children immediately prior to school and immediately after school. However, during school hours and prior to 8:15 a.m. and after 3:15 p.m. the back parking lot, where the basketball hoops are located, is closed to parking due to its use as a play area for the children.

#2 Cardinal Connect – Comes out once every week with important information regarding up coming school events.

#3 Chapel - Our children attend chapel every Wednesday morning starting at 8:40 in the Church. Parents and y siblings are encouraged to attend. A cry room/play area is available for very young children. An offering is taken at every Chapel and is then donated to various charities that change throughout the school year

#4 Free Dress Days - Our children have opportunities throughout the year to participate in free dress days. Generally it is the last full day Friday of every month excluding the month of August, which is open to all children. Free dress coupons are also given to students on their birthday.

#5 Hot Lunch – Currently Subway lunches can be order for Mondays and pizza is available on Fridays. PLEASE be sure to watch for order forms, costs and deadlines. Throughout the year other hot lunches may become available.

#6 Extended care - St. Philip offers excellent before and after school care to students, Jr. Kindergarten through 8th grade, for an extra charge. Any child who is at school prior to 8:15 or after 3:15 will be enrolled in extended care.

#7 Uniforms - You may already be an expert on the St. Philip school uniform but if you are not, the school handbook, pages 15-17, provides a detailed list of uniform do's and don'ts. The school provides a uniform exchange program. You can ask in the school office for more information about used uniforms.

#8 The Library - If you are not already aware, the school has a small but excellent library that your child will have regular access to throughout the year to visit and check out books. Please treat these books as you would any library book, with care and respect.

#9 Music - St. Philip offers optional music lessons at an extra cost for children who are interested in voice or piano. These lessons occur weekly and are scheduled into the regular school day. If you are interested in option music lessons, please contact the school office.

#10 PTO- The Parent Teacher Organization meets monthly in the school library. First meeting is schedule for September 6th at 6:30.
