From the Principal: How safe is your child? Health and safety factors are of major importance to all parents and teachers. All of us want the assurance that our children are protected and in a safe environment. Here are some of the steps we take at St. Philip to insure your child's safety:

- Monthly fire drills are conducted as well as regular earthquake drills
- Fire extinguishers are inspected regularly
- First aid kits and emergency backpacks are in each classroom
- Fully equipped earthquake kits for the entire facility are in place and include medical supplies, food, water, blankets, port-a-potties, etc.
- Emergency procedures including a “lock-down” procedure in place for students and teachers. These drills are scheduled and conducted on a regular basis.
- Entire staff is CPR and First Aid certified
- Recess supervision by staff at all times
- Gates that allow our campus to be a “locked” campus during operating hours
