A Reminder about Personal Belongings

PLEASE make sure to label your child's backpack, lunch box, water bottle, etc., and all clothing with his/her name.

- Students are responsible for their personal property as well as school property assigned to them.
- Whenever items are found by students, they should be turned in promptly to the school office. Items may be claimed by their owners before or after school.
- Periodically, all unclaimed items will be donated to a service agency for distribution to the needy. Announcements regarding Lost and Found items will be made prior to their distribution.

- Electronic devices and games, certain magazines, knives, toy guns, walkie-talkies, magic or trading cards, or any toy action figures that depict violence are not permitted at school.
- Lunch boxes, backpacks, binders or any other items brought to school should not have any reference to drugs, alcohol, tobacco, profanity, action figures that depict violence, or suggestive statements or pictures.
