

## St. Philip's Summer Enrichment Camp

**\*\*\*Class sizes are limited and will fill on a first come, first served basis. Some classes are only offered once so be sure to check the schedule!\*\*\***

**\*\*\*Registration must be turned in on time. Teachers need time to prep and plan lessons. There will be a \$25 late fee for registration within two weeks of a class starting.\*\*\***

**\*\*\*There will be no changing classes last moment. Changes must be made one week in advance and it will only be allowed if the class has room.\*\*\***

**TK & Kinder Class** – this class is specially designed for our younger campers. They will enjoy the same activities as the older campers, however the activities will be tailored to their abilities. They will craft, garden, bake, create art, play games and more. This class is offered mornings and afternoons June 18, July 9 and July 16. During the week of June 25, these younger campers are welcome to join VBS in the morning and Games/Activities/Crafts in the afternoons. Please note that VBS is a **SEPARATE** registration and fee through the church.

**Are You a Fashionista?** – campers will work with art supplies to design and create clothing for each season. Children will also work on designing accessories and shoes to complete their look. Maybe your creation will “walk” the red carpet one day. Afternoons only July 9.

**Amazing Art** – campers will learn and develop skills, while becoming more comfortable with art tools. Children will be exposed to art vocabulary and begin to utilize knowledge of color theory. Campers will be exposed to design principles as they create and explore. Amazing art will offer students the opportunity to utilize different mediums as they draw, paint and create much, much more. Mornings only June 18, July 9 and July 16.

**Beautiful Braids & Sassy Soaps** – campers will learn how to braid, twist and more with their hair. Children will make accessories for their hair too. This class is taught by a licensed cosmetologist. Campers will also make fabulous soaps, fun lip gloss and more through science and crafting. Afternoons only June 18. **LAB FEE \$ 15**

**Better than Sliced Bread** – campers will bake bread, but why stop at traditional bread...? Children will bake a variety of flavors and styles of breads from around the world. They will learn about the bread and fun facts about where it comes from. At the end of the week they will put together the recipes to bring home. Afternoons only July 16. **LAB FEE \$ 15**

**Building the Future with Legos** – this class is perfect for the camper who wants to build the future. Children will be able to design and create their own buildings, vehicles and more. Campers are welcome to bring Legos from home; however it will be their responsibility to keep them separate from the class Legos. Mornings only July 9.

**Fun with Food** – Who says you can't play with your food? Not only should food taste good, but it should look good too. Campers will not simply learn how to make food, but also how to assemble finished foods. The foods won't only taste great, but they will look great too. Afternoons only July 9. **LAB FEE \$15**

**Dreaming of Disney** – “It all started with a mouse...” In this class campers will create crafts, art, fun food and various exciting projects, all with the wonderful theme of Disney. Come have fun creating projects inspired by Mickey and his many friends. Mornings only June 18.

**How Does Your Garden Grow?** – campers will have fun learning about the different aspects of plants in this hands-on gardening class. Children will paint flower pots, garden decorations and make watering cans. They will play in the dirt and possibly create a garden fit for a fairy. Plant/seed projects will come home at the end of the week. Afternoons only July 16. **LAB FEE \$ 15**

**Kitchen Chemistry** – campers will explore how tasty science can be. They will measure and mix different ingredients to create a variety of foods. The children will discuss food groups and nutrition. At the end of the week they will put together a recipe book to bring home. Mornings only July 9. **LAB FEE \$15**

**Pencils on Paper** – campers will participate in directed drawing activities. They will learn how to draw animals and more in a step-by-step style. They will see the pictures come together right in front of their eyes, as they work to complete each step. Afternoons only June 18.

**So You Think You Can Sew** – campers will focus on sewing basics and creative textiles. There may be some tie-dying projects and the favorite flannel blankets too. Each student will create projects using different sewing skills. Campers are required to be 7 or older. This class will close after the first 8 students. Afternoons only July 9 and Mornings only July 16. **LAB FEE \$ 15**

**Sports & Games** – this class will get kids moving. They will learn skills and techniques for sports, play games and have a great time doing it. They will also discuss the importance in staying active. If the weather is nice this class will likely include water games and cool treats too. Mornings and afternoons July 9 and July 16.

**World of Miniatures** – Ever wonder if tiny pies taste as sweet as regular pies? Campers will explore the world from a different point of view in this class. Children will have “big” fun building and creating tiny crafts and little art projects. There will be some tiny cooking with this class too. Afternoons only June 18. **LAB FEE \$ 15**

**VBS** – We are joining St. Philip Church again this year for their VBS, our second week of camp. If you are interested in signing up for this part of camp, please do so **through the church** as they sponsor this activity. Registration and payments for VBS must be made **directly and separately** through the church. We will **not** be holding our regular classes the mornings of June 25.

**Games/Activities/Crafts** – for the afternoon of week 2 we will be playing different games and activities after our busy morning with VBS. All students will stay together with multiple adults supervising. This is for the afternoons of June 25 only.
