- Good at Jamba Juice stand-alone locations (Not valid at locations within grocery stores)



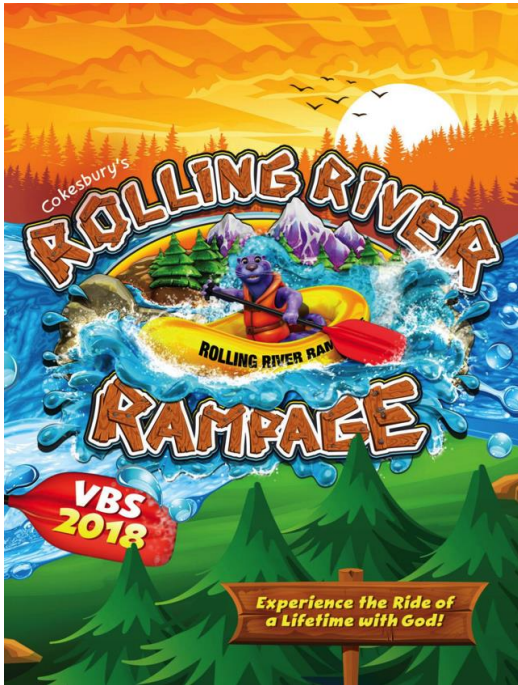
