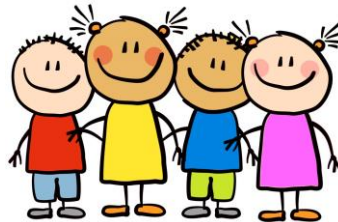

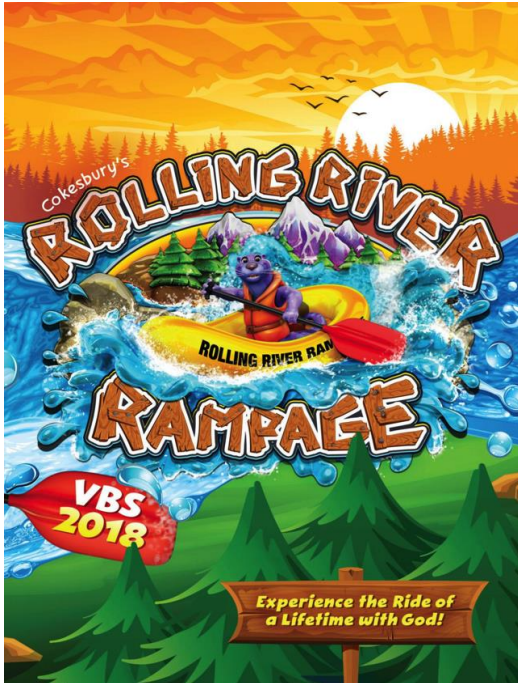
- Nuts
