The intercom system is attached to the extended day care room so it will allow the day care staff to see and speak with people at the gate. If you come to pick up your child from day care and the gate is locked, just push the red button and the bell will ring in the day care room. The staff will then be able to "buzz" you in so that you can sign your child out of day care.

I want to welcome all students and parents to our school, especially those who are new. We have a very professional staff and a safe environment for your child. We have a new Preschool Director, Christine Thung. If you haven't met her, please do. We are excited and looking forward to a great year.

#### **ATTENDANCE**: The key to your child's school success!

- Research show that children who are in school most of the time do better on standardized tests.
- Being late for school hurts a child's learning! A student who is 10 minutes late every day will miss 30 hours of instruction during the year!
- Children can take notes or make up an assignment, but they can never get back what's most important: the discussions, the questions, the explanations by the teacher and the thinking that makes learning come alive!
- Your child's success in school depends on having a solid educational background, one that only can be gained through regular school attendance.

Schools are responsible for teaching your child...but, schools can't do their job if your child is absent. Learning builds day by day. A child who misses a day of school misses a day of learning!

Here are some ways of building your child's school attendance:

- Talk to them about the importance of school attendance
- Avoid scheduling family trips or doctors appointments during school
- Help them stay healthy by eating nutritious food and getting enough sleep and exercise
- Discuss what happened at school each day
- Support school rules
